It's not planned, BUT YOU CAN PLAN ON IT! Puppy & Kitten Season

Most of us look forward to spring with great anticipation. The days are longer and the nights a little warmer. Our grass turns greener, and the plants and flowers blossom. It's all good, right? Sadly, there is also a downside for those who work or volunteer at animal shelters. For us, it signals an early start to the most dreaded time of the year: puppy, and, in this immediate area especially, kitten season. They're adorable. They're cute. But they all need to be vaccinated, dewormed, microchipped, spayed/neutered, and tested for diseases. It takes a lot of resources to care for a puppy or a kitten. Even more for a litter. It takes a community to care for dozens of litters and your help is needed! The adoption fee does not even begin to cover the cost of food, veterinary care, and necessary supplies.

As a community, we need to address the problem where it begins, by preventing the birth of unwanted litters of dogs

and cats. Spay and neuter is the logical solution to reducing pet overpopulation and decreasing euthanasia. If your pet is not spayed or neutered, check out spayUSA.org for a low-cost voucher redeemable at veterinarians in your area.

Do me a favor and don't forget about the adult cats and dogs that are also in need of their forever homes. Puppies and kittens are so adorable, but this season can be heartbreaking to see potential adopters ignore the older pets because the puppies and kittens are stealing the show. With so many litters flooding shelters, it becomes more difficult for adult pets to be given that second chance. Check out ALL our adoptable cats and dogs at fapspet.org/adopt.

Through pet adoption and spaying and neutering, we can become a no-kill community and I truly believe that. Then spring would be a happier season for all.

Tips for Stress Free Vet Visits for Your Dog – How you can help

- Choose the right vet. The entire clinic staff should be sensitive to your dog's needs. If a vet isn't interested in accommodating you, find one who is.
- Follow each vet visit with your dog's favorite activity.
- Make your first visit an opportunity to get acquainted – to sniff around the waiting room, meet the vet and the staff, and have a pleasant experience free of pesky exams or shots.
- Have the clinic staff give your dog lots of top-quality treats

each visit. If a dog gets delicious treats while at the vet, then he is more likely to be cooperative about going there.

- Plan your clinic entrances and exits to make them as free of stress as possible. At some clinics, a staff member will come to your car or call your cell phone to let you know it's your turn.
- Finally, maintain a calm frame of mind yourself. Your emotions are contagious – the more cheerful and relaxed you are, the more you can help your dog.
